

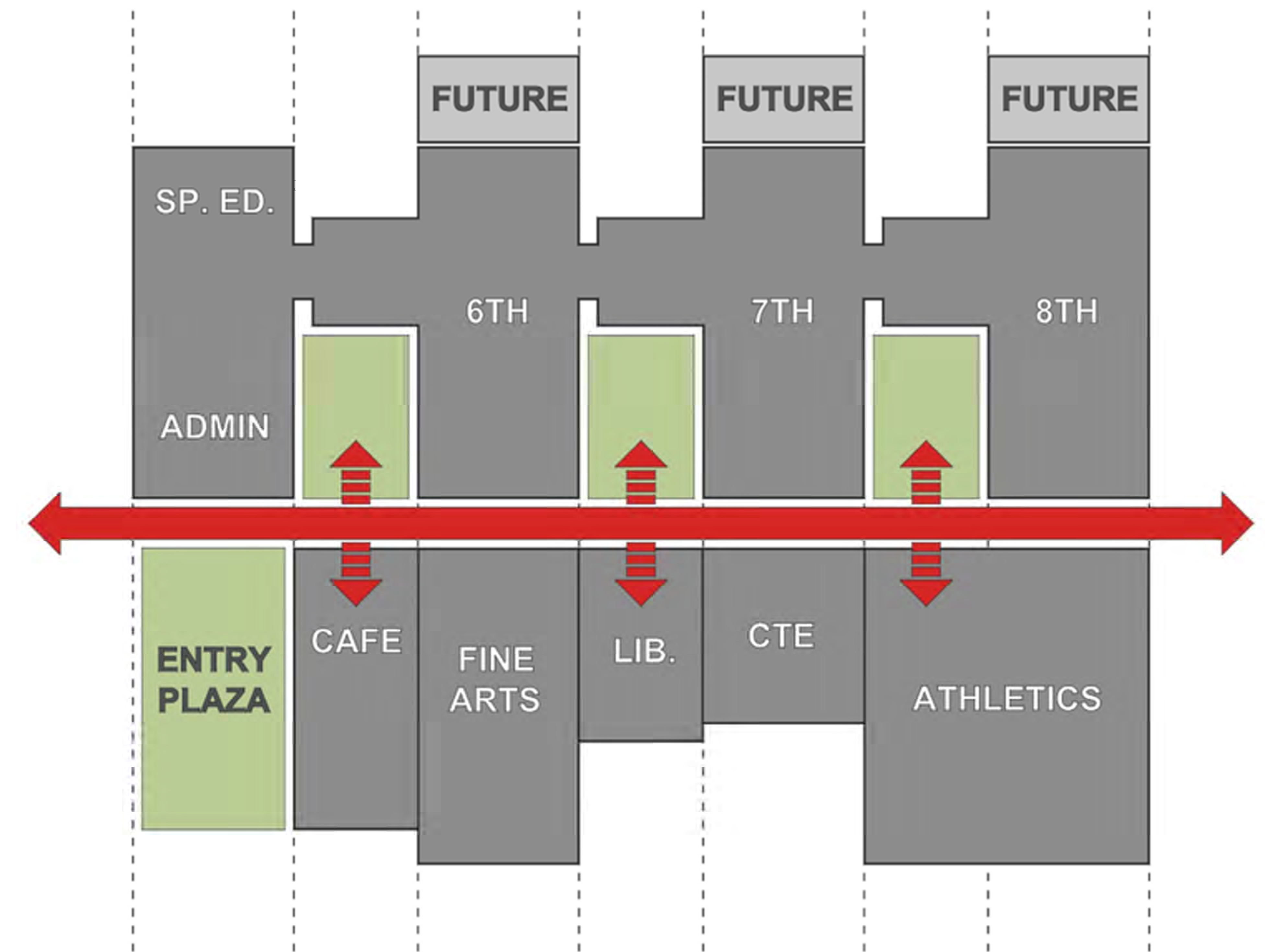
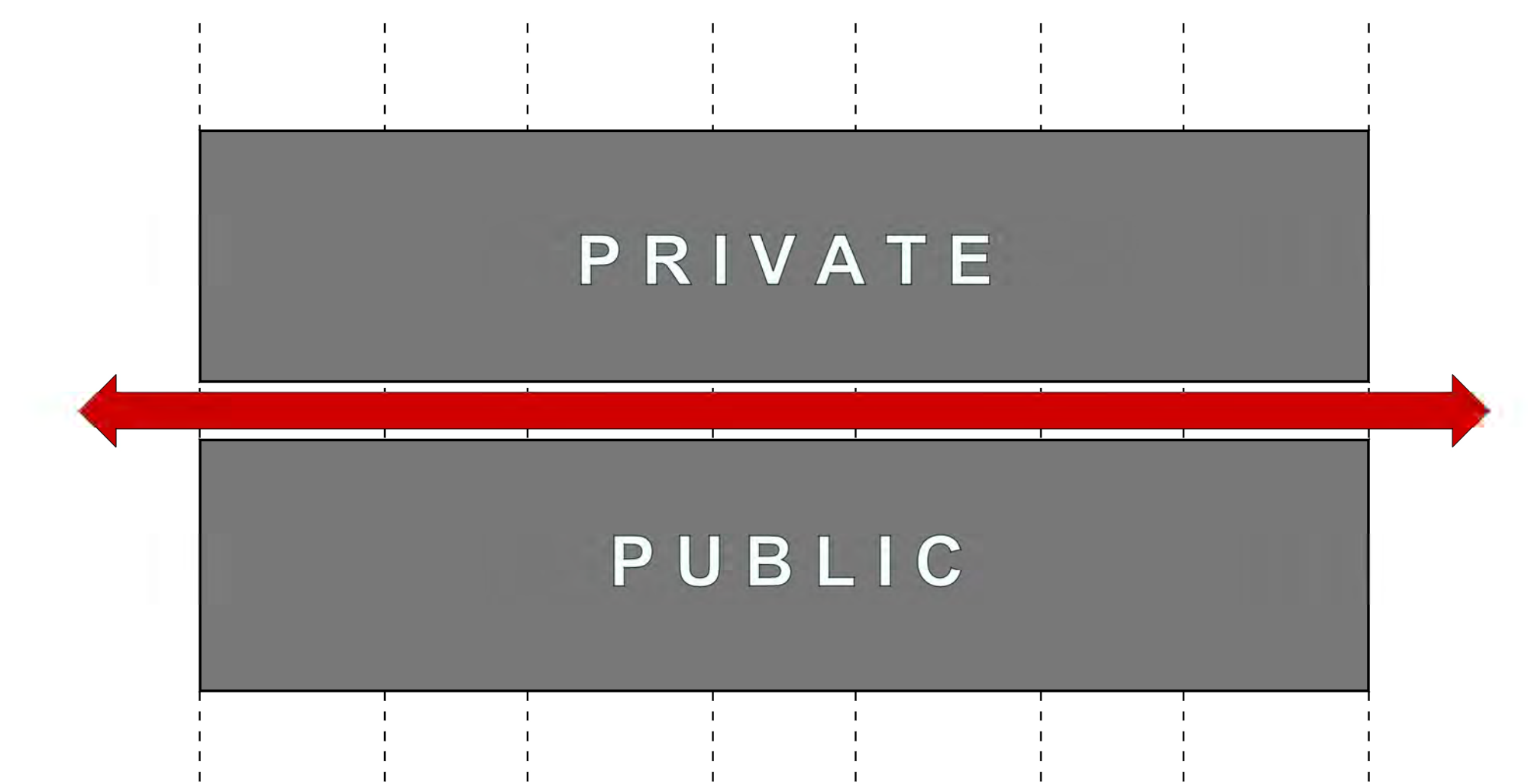
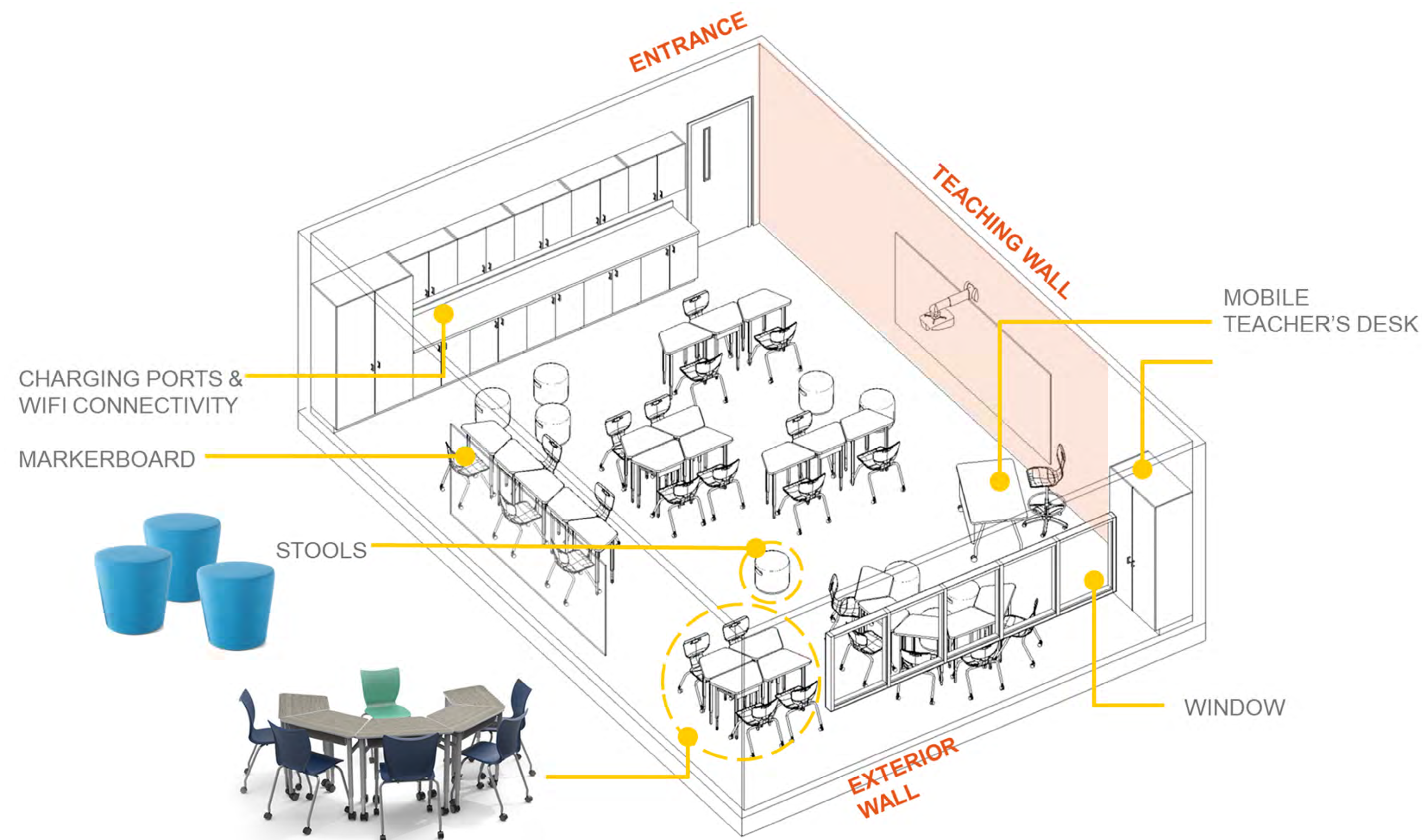
BUILDING SAFETY

78% of surveyors want wider, long hallways within the classroom organization to improve security. A wide central hallway separates the PRIVATE classroom spaces to the north and PUBLIC community spaces to the south. It is organized with a Main Entry Vestibule and Administration at the beginning of this wide central hallway to increase security. This allows visitors to enter the building while keeping classrooms secure. Wide hallways continue into the classroom areas and classrooms are organized to have natural light from three secure courtyards.

COMMUNITY PRIORITY #2

77% of surveyors want classrooms to be flexible, collaborative learning areas. Flexible furniture allows teacher's the ability to layout their classrooms to fit the curriculum and gives students the opportunity to change their environment throughout the day. Each classroom would also have a primary teaching wall along with plenty of storage for supplies. An exterior window provides natural light to every classroom.
